Define the solution before the purchase

Describe your existing environment, sites, connectivity, capacity, resilience needs and internal skills. Agree the product selection, integration, delivery responsibilities and acceptance criteria as part of the proposed engagement.

Questions for an HPE networking engagement

- Which HPE Networking product family fits the requirement?
- What current authorisations and technical certifications apply to that product family?
- Who owns design, configuration, migration, testing and documentation?
- What support is provided by blueAPACHE and what is provided by HPE?
- What comparable delivery experience can be evidenced?
- How are licensing, warranties, renewals and ongoing support priced?

A general HPE partnership should not be treated as proof of a particular HPE Networking or Aruba tier. Confirm the current product-specific status in the proposal.

blueAPACHE's Platforms offer focuses on enterprise needs, while Technology services span small organisations through to global enterprises. The required solution and delivery scope determine fit; the company's mid-market managed-services focus is not a company-wide seat limit.
