- Comparable customer experience that blueAPACHE can substantiate.
- Commercial terms, renewal arrangements and exit responsibilities.

Organisation size and engagement

Technology services can support organisations from small businesses through to global enterprises. A full managed service is one option; the engagement should follow your requirements and internal capability rather than a fixed seat-count band.
